REGULATORY FRAMEWORK COMMITTEE

Monitor implementation and effectiveness of the University's General Regulations and Academic Regulations and Policies.

Consider requests for local variations to University Regulations.

Make recommendations regarding intermediate awards or individually designed programmes in individual cases.

Consider risks and their mitigation in relation to the University Regulatory Framework.

Support the continuous enhancement of teaching quality in the context of the Town House Strategy.

Ensure the QAE framework safeguards standards and underpins student success and that external quality assessment requirements are met.

Identify strategic planning priorities for the University's academic portfolio and approve changes to the portfolio including new partnerships.

Monitor PSRB, KCEP, IQA, validation and institutional approval and accreditations.
