KINGSTON UNIVERSITY HUNTING AND FISHING POLICY

Policy Aim

Kingston University is committed to conserving and enhancing biodiversity across its estate and landholdings. As a result, activities that lead to the injury or killing of wildlife on our sites, including all hunting and fishing activities are banned on Kingston University landholdings.

Policy Objectives

In accordance with the Hunting and Fishing Policy Aim. The Policy Objectives below seeks to restrict Hunting and Fishing Activities and amenity activities that use projectile weapons on the Estate to those in the categories listed.:

1. Under no circumstances are any projectile weapons including but not limited to air rifles, bows and arrows and catapult slings allowed in any outside spaces on Kingston University premises.
2. The use of projectile weapons during specific amenity activities such as archery sports, will only be allowed in designated indoor and specified outdoor pitches in the course of a university authorised activity.
3. In line with our river restoration works, fishing activities are not permitted from or on University premises including university owned or managed river banks and river courses.
4. The use of unauthorised projectile weapons on our premise will be reported to the authorities.

This Hunting and Fishing Policy is owned by KU Estates & Sustainability and is reviewed every two years by the Estate Committee.
