Policy Objectives

In accordance with the Biodiversity Policy Vision, the management of biodiversity at Kingston University will be undertaken in accordance with the following objectives:

- 1. To comply with all statutory legislation regarding biodiversity and maintain documented records of our compliance obligations.
- 2. To conserve and enhance habitats across the Kingston University campuses through implementation of the Kingston University Biodiversity Action Plan (KUBAP)
- 3. To consider ecological impacts and opportunities for ecological enhancement of relevant building refurbishments and relevant new buildings or construction activity.
- 4. To lead effective grounds management practices which conserve and enhance biodiversity while seeking opportunities to minimise operating costs.
- 5. To educate students and staff on the value of biodiversity and raise awareness of the conservation work that is undertaken by Kingston University in the context of the KUBAP, thus aligning with Kingston University Sustainability Plan.
- 6. To ensure that all biodiversity works across areas, are done efficiently and cost effectively, without compromising legislative biodiversity compliance.
